Seminar on 'Deceased Organ Donor Transplantation' at Nadiad

A seminar on 'Deceased Organ Donor Transplantation' was organised by Dr. (Smt.) Sujata Rajapurkar, Medical Social Worker and Transplant Co-ordinator, Muljibhai Patel Urological Hospital for the board members, employees and volunteers of IRF on 2nd August, 2017.

All distinguished and learned doctors of the Muljibhai Patel Urological Hospital (MPUH) educated us on different topics related to Deceased Organ Donor Transplantation. Dr. A. K. 
