Along with this, the second wave also shook our life cycle and the economy of our country. People's jobs were adversely affected and a large number of people became unemployed. In such negative situations, seeing the way the vaccination campaign is going on in the country. I hope that all our lives will be restored. My heartfelt congratulations to all the "Corona Warriors" who have risked their lives to save our lives during this unprecedented time.

The organization is providing timely and qualitative dialysis treatment to the patients coming for treatment at our Dialysis Centre Himmatnagar during Covid-19 and a lift has been arranged by our organization so that the kidney patients do not have any problem in climbing the stairs in Dialysis Centre. I appeal to all of you to help as much as possible in this campaign.

Chronic Kidney Failure (CRF) is Silent Killer. There are no specific symptoms of it. Hence kidney failure can be prevented if diagnosed early. As part of the Kidney Awareness Campaign run by the organization, it works to provide accurate and scientific information about the kidneys to the people of the society, but we all know that diabetes and high blood pressure can cause serious consequences to the kidneys if not treated properly. So the organization is conducting a free BP-Diabetes Check-up Camp in rural areas. So that people stay healthy and wholesome.

Expressing my condolences, I would like to inform you with great sadness that Shri Jitendrabhai Dalia, a member of the Advisory Committee of Surat Chapter has passed away on April 4, 2021. ShriJitendrabhai had been associated with our organization for the last 6 years; the organization will always remember his work for the time and the service he has rendered to the organization.

According to an estimate 2, 10,000 people suffer from Chronic Kidney Disease in our country every year, i.e. 575 patients have kidney failure in a day.

With this in mind, on World Kidney Day 2021, the organization has launched a mission "Mission 575 – Let's move towards a healthy future together". Especially in rural areas most people are not aware of the adverse effects on other parts of the body due to physical problems like BP and diabetes. To take this mission further, we conduct Kidney Check-up (Creatinine – Urine R&M) camps and Awareness Programs for People suffering from BP and Diabetes in rural areas.

So that early diagnosis can start their treatment as early as possible and prevent kidney disease.

The government's guideline was strictly adhered to by keeping proper social distance in the BP, Diabetes and Kidney Screening Camp (Creatinine – Urine R&M) conducted by the organization under "Mission 575 – Let's move towards a healthy future together".

Namaste!

My name is Ganesh Rajaram Patil. I am 30 years old and I am a resident of Navagam, Surat. In the year 2015, while I was working in a diamond company in Surat, I was immediately admitted to the government hospital at Sahara Darwaza with symptoms of kidney failure. On May 24th, 2015, i was diagnosed with kidney failure. The doctor said that now you have to undergo dialysis, the word dialysis was heard for the first time, the first step in treating dialysis is to operate on a hand-held A.V. fistula to remove large amounts of blood, which was done but stopped working after it worked well until about 2020. So I got into a lot of trouble.

Due to physical problems, the doctor said that you will not be able to undergo a second operation for A.V. Fistula, so the doctor advised me to have a permacath operation. The cost of this operation is Rs. 40,000 / - which was not affordable to a poor man like me. Since I had no other option of treatment, I had to undergo throat dialysis by DLC for 8 months in which I had to suffer a lot.

After receiving information about India Renal Foundation from my friend, I contacted the organization and talked about the cost of my permacath operation. The organization informed me that the permacath operation at IKDRC Hospital at Ahmedabad Civil Campus was being done at a concessional rate and I decided to perform the operation there at a cost of Rs. 15000 / -. The entire cost of the operation was borne by the India Renal Foundation. I truly thank the India Renal Foundation for helping me at the right time so that I could undergo my operation on time. Currently my dialysis is done on time and my health is very good.

There are many patients like Ganesh Patil who come to our organization hoping to get financial help for treatment and the organization helps such patients as much as possible. It is our humble request that the philanthropist people of the society come forward to help patients like Ganesh for treatment and donate generously under the 'Save a Life' program run by the organization so that the lives of patients like Ganesh can be saved.

He was immediately admitted to Venus Hospital Surat. On Sunday, June 27, 2021, he was declared brain dead. His family was devastated by the tragedy. Even in such a tragic situation, his wife Rinkuben and family members made a noble decision to donate Giteshbhai's organs. We honour Giteshbhai's family members for this decision which is very appreciable and helpful for the society.

Giteshbhai went on to make the statement that life should not be long but inspiring in the true sense of the word.
