We are proud and delighted to share that India Renal Foundation (IRF) has turned twenty in January 2022. Thank you for your continuous support and belief in IRF.

On this occasion, I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to the donor members, doctors and volunteers as well as those who have contributed directly & indirectly for their invaluable assistance from the society. Your cooperation and guidance has inspired us to achieve this goal and help the needy survivors.

Public Awareness Programs are the core activities of the organization, which is currently on going in the villages of Gujarat. Kidney Failure is a traumatic and fatal disease, thus it is our responsibility to educate the society on the importance of having healthy kidneys for a healthy life. We know kidney disease can be easily detected with blood pressure, blood sugar and kidney test. Timely diagnosis and treatment can prevent the progression of incurable disease such as Chronic Renal Failure (CRF). Therefore it is need of the hour to make society aware about renal problems and its serious emerging complications.

During this time, we organized 226 awareness programmes and 72 screening Camps were held across Gujarat, with people being made attentive through these Programmes in various talukas and villages of the Vadodara, Surat, Anand, Panchmahal, Mehsana, Rajkot, Bhavnagar, Gandhinagar and Ahmedabad districts.

Organ Donation Day is celebrated on August 13 in our country. In India there is lack of awareness about Cadaveric Organ Donation. As a result, 90% of patients waiting for organ donation die due to non-availability of organs. On this day, we organized various programs in our different chapters and explain the importance of organ donation by different activities and by sharing the experience of new lease of life by recipients.

In the year 2006, a programme called 'Prerana' was started by the organization with the aim of making life easier for kidney patients. Kidney patients undergoing dialysis across Gujarat are encouraged to have recreational space and time through Prerana's activities. During diwali 'Prerana' gives an opportunity to showcase their talent and bring out their artistic skills. In this year members enthusiastically participated and made 6000 fancy diyas, which was sold by IRF team and money was given to the needful prerana members to uplift them financially.

Under the 'Save a Life' Programme, we have been supporting indigent kidney patients across Gujarat, by providing them dialysis kits and medicines every month. We are assisting them for the surgery expenses of A.V. fistula. The Foundation provided Rs.4, 75, 754/- to the patients in last six months.

We are grateful to Shri Rashmikantbhai J. Shah, Advisory committee member of Ahmedabad chapter by donating Rs. 6,00,000/- to the Surat chapter for launching a medical van for conducting awareness programmes and diagnosis camps in the villages across the South Gujarat.

## **Organ Donation Day**

As you all know the organization's core activity, is to create awareness about kidneys and kidney diseases in the society. For the last 20 years the IRF has been educating the society about kidney disease in the Gujarat's major cities as well as in the small villages. We've all seen that, as a result of our modern lifestyles, the incidence of Chronic Kidney Disease has been rising in society, owing to diabetes, high blood pressure and lack of knowledge about kidneys.

Accidental brain death (brain dead) person is certain to die, but at the same time, the patient's vital and useful organs are also destroyed. As long as the person is on ventilator, patient's non brain organs (kidney, liver, eye, lungs, heart and pancreas) can be transplant in the organ failure patients with the consent of the brain dead patient relative.

Six people lives can be saved by donating the organs of brain dead person.

Since 2006, the India Renal Foundation have been educating the society though a programme of 'Jeevandan.' On the 13th of August 2021, we held various programmes as part of this initiative such as:

### **Ahmedabad**

Dr. Umesh Godhani (Nephrologist) gave detailed information about Cadaver Organ Donation to the students of J.G. International Nursing College and also explained them in very simple language that what is duty and role will be while working in the medical field after the completion of their nursing studies. Organ donation card were field out by each student in the programme. They were also made an aware to increase Cadaver Organ Donation. The principal of the college, Dr. Sunitha Mathew, was also present at the presentation and promised to work together in the future to awaken the people of the society in this subject.

### Surat

On the day of organ donation, the students of Vibrant Nursing College run by Shri Swaminarayan Education Trust's at Surat olpad were educated about organ donation. As well as they were aware about the duty and role of nursing staff in the hospital during the Cadaveric Organ Donation process. In this program we had also invited Dr. Jinesh Purohit (Nephrologist). He gave the students a better knowledge about the subject of this field through projector. A unique plays and art competition was also organised by college students with the encouragement of the college principal with the goal of raising awareness about organ donation. The winner students were awarded by Dr. Jignesh Purohit. The Shri Swaminarayan Education Trust has made a donation of Rs. 5000/-We appreciate them.

### **Vadodara**

# We would like to share with you the feelings of a Cadaveric organ donation receiver on this occasion.



Rakesh Patel

My name is Rakesh Patel and I live in Himmatnagar when I was a kid, my kidney got damaged due to an accident. My kidney function restored to normal after I was initially treated with the medicines. Suddenly after two years I began vomiting and was told to have certain medical tests, which led to my diagnosis of chronic renal disease in 2003. My kidney was transplanted in 2007 and that kidney worked for seven years.

I had to restart haemodialysis treatment in 2014. In 2018 India Renal Foundation opened its dialysis centre with state of art facilities in Himmatnagar, after knowing these I took a visit of the centre and then decided to have my haemodialysis treatment there. After these for the continuously 3 years I took my haemodialysis treatment at IRF's dialysis centre. On

November 24, 2021, I received a call from sterling hospital at 8 pm for Cadaver Organ Donation and without doing any delay we arrived these promptly. The physicians got several medical tests on me on 25th of November 2021, later on they took me to the operation theatre at 8 am and after a successful operation a new kidney was transplanted in my body. I got a new kidney of 42 year old brain dead person and I am thankful to his family members, that they were aware of the organ donation. I would like to express my gratitude to that family for giving me a new life by donating the organ of their relatives.

Now I am no longer on dialysis and by god's grace, I am living a healthy life after a kidney transplantation and at the last, I urge to every person of the society to come forward for organ donation as a responsible citizen, seeing organ donation as a shared responsibility so that patients with in curable conditions like me can be received.

Mehulbhai Jayantibhai Makwana

My name is Mehul Jayantibhai Makwana, and I am a Morbi inhabitant. Dr. Praful Gajjar (Nephrologist), a kidney specialist, confirmed my kidney failure in 2014. After that, I was able to avoid dialysis treatment to his advice and medicines, but the doctor's fees and medicines was not affordable to me, so I went to Ahmedabad Civil Hospital in 2016 for an evaluation by nephrologist Dr. Himanshu Patel.

Then, in the year 2020, when my creatinine level rose, the doctor urged me to begin dialysis therapy, but before doing so, I sought surgery for A.V. Fistula. I had to have surgery at BT Savani Hospital in Rajkot, which failed a few days later, so I had to have surgery again at Madhuram Hospital in Rajkot, which also failed. We went to Civil Hospital Ahmedabad for AV Fistula surgery because I didn't have any. I went in for a fistula surgery, but the physicians told us there would be a three-month delay and that we should schedule an

appointment after that. My health problems were worsening, so I needed dialysis on a regular basis. I contacted Ashwinbhai Gohel at the India Renal Foundation Rajkot office and assured him of my assistance after a patient buddy who came with us for treatment requested that we contact an organisation called India Renal Foundation. We scheduled an operation a few days later from his Ahmedabad office. We were summoned to Ahmedabad, where Dr. Dilip Trivedi was working at Ved Hospital where my third fistula operation was successful. This surgery will cost Rs. 26,000/- and Rs. 6000/- according to the report, the entire cost of my operation was Rs. 32,000/- with India Renal Foundation covering all my costs. The India Renal Foundation did indeed assist me at the appropriate moment, and I am now able to receive my dialysis treatment on time. I am heartily thankful to IRF.
